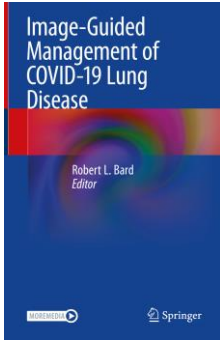

### REVIEW

COVID-19 has produced an enormous challenge to all aspects of medicine, as highlighted by this publication. This multi-author book with chapters by various experts has its strengths and weaknesses.

As a radiologist I looked forward to the chapters on imaging, in particular CT. This chapter is excellent, describing the evolution of the understanding of the disease and the characteristic findings. The text is clear and the images are first class.

However, much of the publication relates to other issues such as sanitisers, PPE, ultraviolet light applications and respiratory dynamics.

There is very extensive description and discussion regarding ultrasound, including Doppler in COVID-19 even including remote ultrasound.

In this evolving field there is no discussion on the impact of new variants and only in the last paragraph on page 155 are vaccines very briefly mentioned.

So, should you read this publication? Well, in part – just the chapter on CT evaluation and perhaps a brief review of the extensive sections on ultrasound.
