

Written some 29 years after its first edition, the seventh edition of Greenspan and Beltran's *Orthopaedic Imaging* does not cease to amaze its readers. This eloquently written 1,488-page textbook of orthopaedic imaging contains 4,000 high quality images, including conventional radiographs, ultrasound, CT including 3D, PETCT and dual energy CT, MRI including PETMR.

Encompassing up-to-date discussions of conditions/imaging findings such as Postel coxarthropathy, 'surfer's knots', floating PIGHL lesion, 'lava lamp sign', FOPE (focal periphyseal oedema), and treatments such as autologous chondrocyte transplantation, this textbook is a compelling read for medical students, orthopaedic and radiology trainees and consultants, and physiotherapists alike.

The textbook is divided into seven parts, namely introduction and techniques, trauma, arthritides, tumours and tumour-like lesions, infections, metabolic and endocrine disorders and congenital/developmental anomalies. In this new edition, additional material covering sports injuries (incorporating less common conditions such as handlebar palsy, bowler's thumb), and cartilage imaging are included.

The reasons to buy this textbook are the excellent readability, good descriptions of pathology, pathomechanisms of disease, and the accompanying radiologic images. The vast sum and quality of the radiologic images reflects the authors' immense experience in this field. In some cases, additional arthroscopic finding correlations are also provided; these are most beneficial for the radiologists who may not have assisted in orthopaedic theatre in their training. 3D CT helps the reader visualise and understand pathology to a higher level.

There are very minor negatives: weighing 5kg the textbook is not easily portable. This is, however, mitigated by the publishers providing the enhanced online eBook (obtained when purchasing the physical book). A version is available on iOS, Android, PC and Mac. The other minor negative is its rather high price.

Overall, I would highly recommend this textbook of musculoskeletal and orthopaedic radiology. It contains a wealth of knowledge that is indispensable for the radiologist, orthopaedic surgeon, medical student and physiotherapist interested in bone and soft tissue conditions.
