

#### **REVIEW**

The fourth edition of Fananapazir and Foster's Diagnostic Imaging — Genitourinary has been compiled by distinguished radiology colleagues based in the United States. The book is sub-divided into 13 anatomically-defined sections of clinical cases with explanatory text and images, spread over 653 pages. It covers all the key aspects of the genitourinary system, from the retroperitoneum and adrenals down to the urethra, scrotum and prostate. A separate chapter on genitourinary procedures covers percutaneous genitourinary interventions, renal ablation, embolisation and biopsies, and adrenal and renal venography.

The book is lavishly illustrated by radiological and anatomical diagrams of the very highest quality, making the book a joy to behold. Clinical cases are superbly illustrated, making this a great resource for the visual learner. The mix of CT, MR, ultrasound, and angiographic pictures show vivid real-life examples of a wide variety of conditions.

The overall format is easy to understand and accessible, which will prove invaluable for its use as a benchbook for clinical sessions. The table of contents provides a colour coordinated list for ease of access and prompt location of cases.

Each chapter is split logically by aetiology such as congenital; infection; trauma; iatrogenic; benign and malignant neoplasm. Extensive accompanying text is divided into lists. While this text format may not initially be to everyone's liking, it enables relatively large volumes of salient information to be easily accessible in an easy-to-read format. This will prove invaluable for baseline learning or focused revision before fellowship examinations.


